Home Upgrade combines multiple improvements to increase your home's overall energy efficiency, saving you energy and money. Eligible home improvements include:

- Air sealing
- Duct sealing
- Insulation
- High-efficiency furnaces
- High-efficiency air conditioners
- High-efficiency water heaters
- High-efficiency windows

Are You Eligible?

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) customers* who own a single-family detached home are eligible for Home Upgrade incentives.



More Upgrades Mean Higher Incentives

All base and flex upgrade measures are worth a pre-determined number of points that count toward your Home Upgrade incentive. You must choose a minimum of three total upgrade measures. The more points you earn by combining upgrades, the higher the incentives you can receive.

Incentives are awarded at \$10 per point up to a maximum of \$3,000. An additional \$150 incentive is available to offset combustion safety testing costs of completed projects. There is a minimum of 100 points for a \$1,000 rebate.

Points to Incentives
1 Point = \$10 in incentives
